National Seminars organized in the College



A 2 day Interdisciplinary National Seminar on the theme – Rural Development Paradigm and Livelihood Security in India was organized by the Department of Sociology in which 280 researchers from different states took part.

Training and Placement Cell

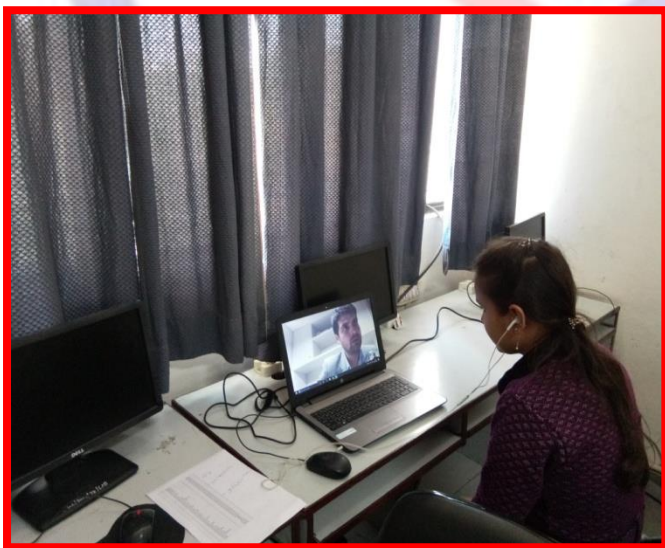
