Two-Day National Seminar on “Applications of Mathematics in the Present Scenario”

The semester has got fresh gust of research and thought as it has got the opportunity to organize a Two Day National Conference on the Theme “Applications of Mathematics in Present Scenario”. Here is the brief report of the Seminar.

Day 1, November 10, 2017.

The event opened with the floral welcome of the guests and lighting of the lamp in front of goddess Saraswati. Dr. Vijay Chawla, Convener of the Conference welcomed the guests and threw light on the areas to which Mathematics is applicable, many a time even without our knowledge. Dr. P.K. Bajpai, Principal of the college highlighted the importance of knowledge of Mathematics by putting examples from his personal experience. Prof. Anil Vashisth, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra opened the talk with his keynote address which acted as a stimulus in firing up the thought of the delegates how arrived not only from Haryana but also from neighboring states.

He co-related Mathematics with other branches of knowledge and enlightened the guests. Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Ahuja, University Institute of Engineering and Technology threw light on the modern trends in the field of Mathematics.

One Boy volunteer participated in the NSS Trial Camp for NSS Pre Republic Day Parade on 22th September 2017.

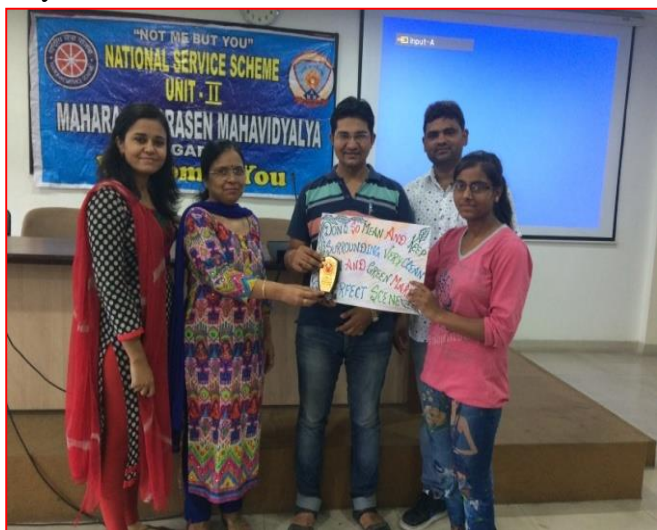
