National Seminars organized in the College

One on the theme “The format of good governance system and its use in the present times in Sanskrit scriptures” by the department of Economics and the other one on the theme “New India: Opportunities and Challenges” by the Department of Commerce. Here is a brief report of the Seminars.

“Good Governance in Sanskrit Shastras”



The very first seminar of this semester was organized by the Economics Department on 26/02/2018 which was sponsored by Haryana Sanskrit Academy, Panchkula on the theme “Good Governance in Sanskrit Shastras”. The seminar was presided by Dr Someshwar Dutt, Director of the

Academy. The semantics in the seminar were presented by Dr. Ashutosh.



The seminar was inaugurated by lighting the Lamp. Dr P.K Bajpai, Principal of the college Welcomed all the guests and participants from different parts of the state on their arrival in the college campus. Dr. Bajpai said that being a medium for the promotion of such great topic is a matter of proud for the institute. Dr. Bajpai appreciated the Director of Sanskrit Academy and said that the initiative taken by the Director to organize seminars like this is very useful and to take the resolution of preserving the ancient cultural heritage and Sanskrit texts will motivate our young generation and the teacher community.

In the seminar, Dr. Someshwar Dutt, Director of Sanskrit Sahitya Academy, along with Dr. Virendra Singh, Mr. Rajiv Ranjan, Dr. Neeraj Atri,

Mr. A.K. Shourie, Shri Ashutosh, Shri Balabhpradas Shree Oberoi etc. while presenting their views highlighted the Sanskrit language, the Indian values in Sanskrit texts, Indian ideals and rich culture in detail. On 22.02.2018, the camp was inaugurated by Hon'ble Principal, Dr. P.K. Bajpai and Dr. Bhadur Singh (Previous NSS Officer). In his inaugural address, Dr. P.K. Bajpai motivated and encouraged the NSS volunteers to do community service in the village and gave his best wishes for the camp. Dr. Shiv Kumar of Civil Hospital, Yamuna Nagar informed the volunteers about the importance of Yoga and motivated them to cultivate the habit of performing Yoga daily. After the Yoga practice, the volunteers along with the Programme Officers planted several trees in the Government Sr. Sec. School, Parwalon.
