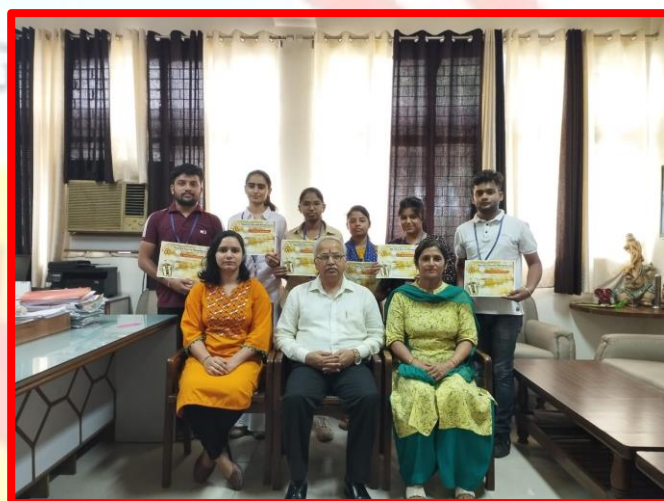
A Cooking without fire competition was organized on 2nd May 2022. Students prepared Mouth Watering dishes without using fire.

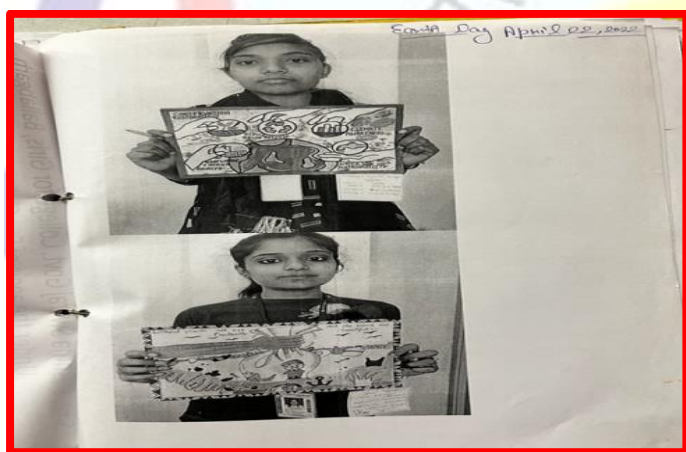
Students participated in “Inter College Painting & Portrait “ Competitions on 16th April,2022 in Guru Nanak Girls College , Yamunanagar.

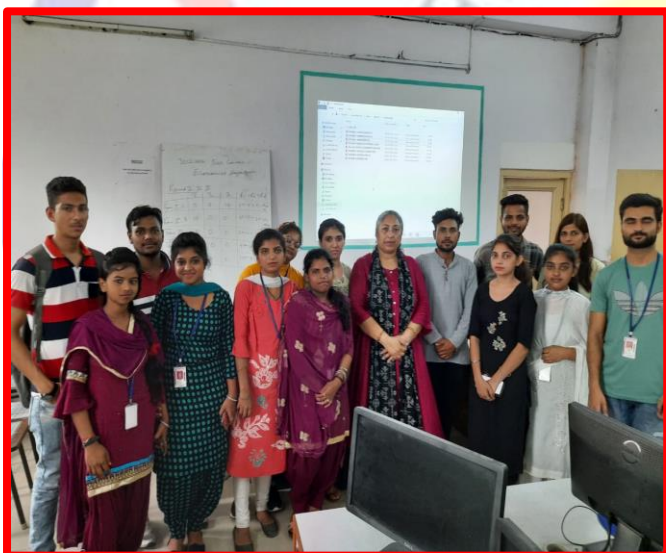

Conducted B certificate NCC exam in the College Premises for the entire Ambala Zone on 6th March 2022. Total 327 Cadets appeared for the Exam.

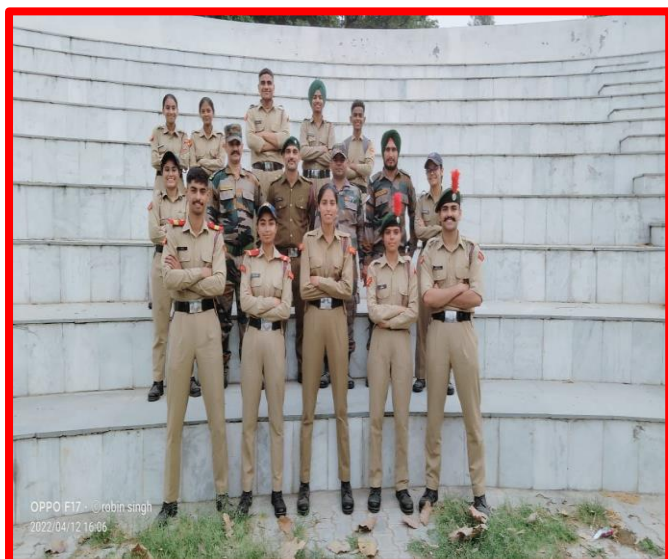


5 Cadets registered themselves as Aapda Mitra Volunteers on 22rd March 2022.

Classes for the Personality Development, Increasing Computer Proficiency and Verbal ability were organized by the Cell for the Final Year students of the college in the month of May and June.

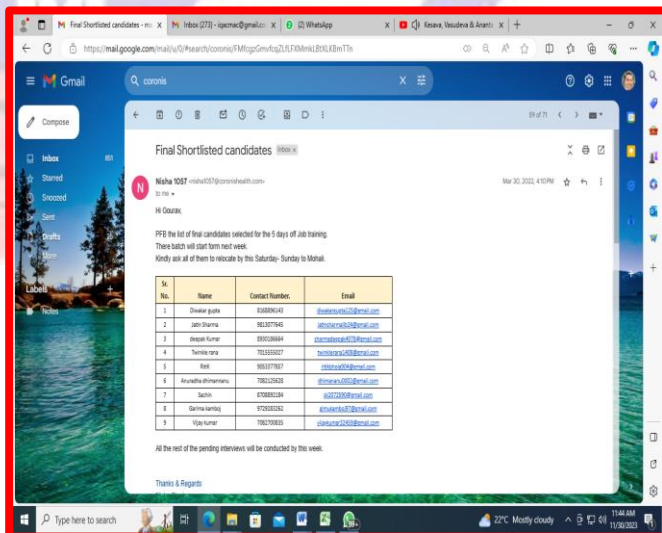
A Placement drive with Coronis IT Systems Mohali was organized for the final year students of the college and the city on 13th may 2022.

Organized College level Essay writing competition in collaboration with Civil Hospital Yamuna nagar regarding HIV/AIDS on 26 March 2022.

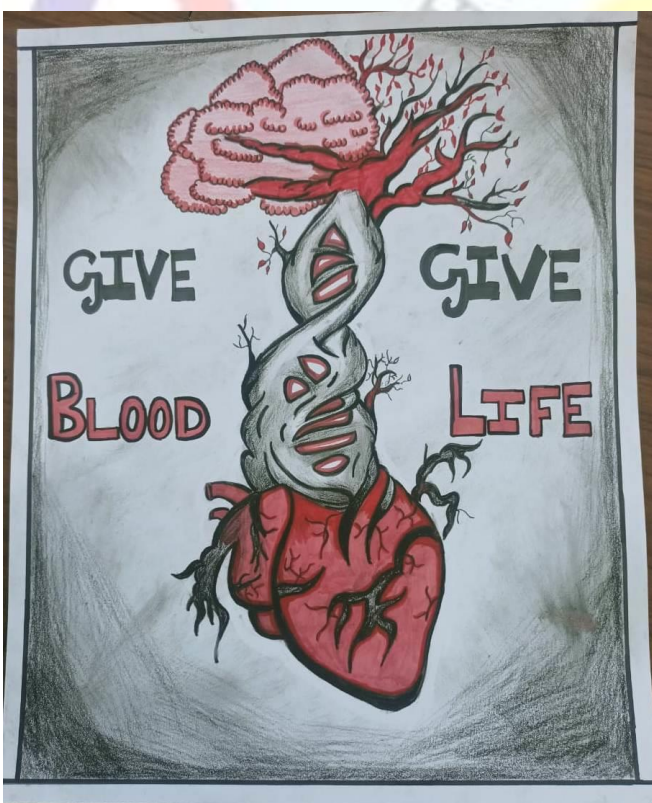
