A very healthy discussion was followed after each presentation.



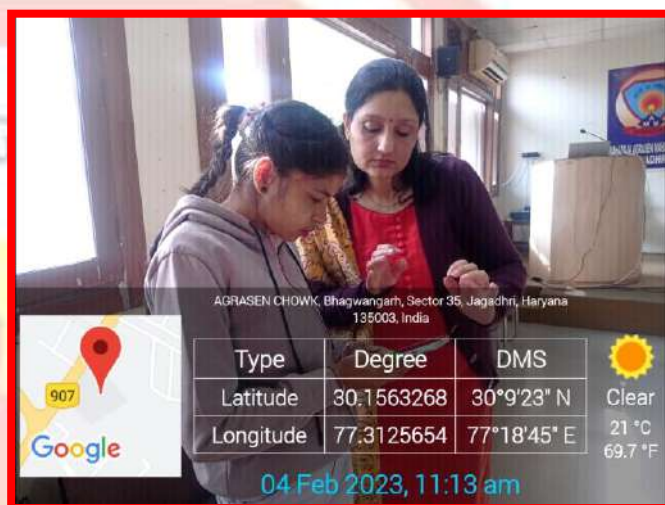

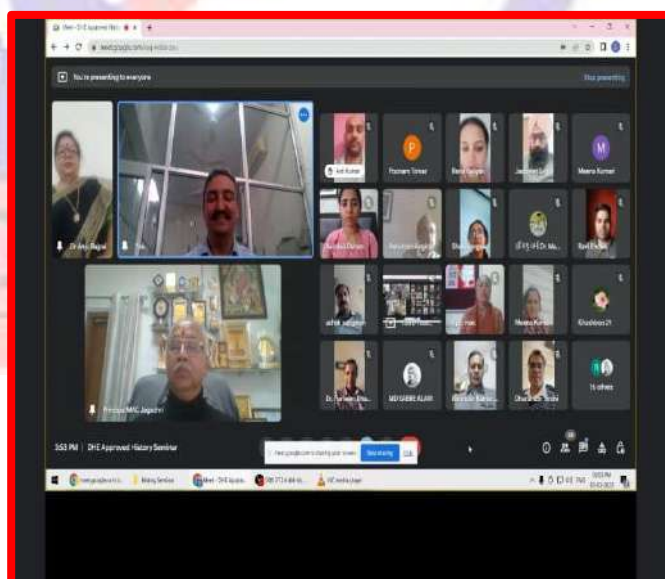

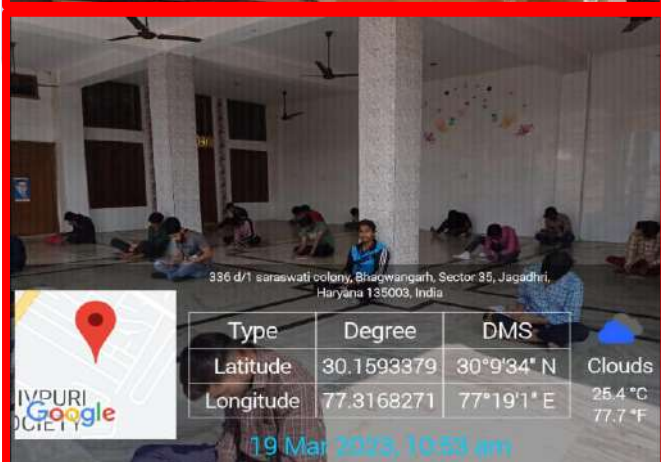


## ***National Service Scheme Unit II***

### Day 1

#### Early Morning

NSS Volunteers and the Programme Officer Dr. Rakhi visited Adopted Village Mandkheri ki Tapriyan from the college after getting the blessings of College Principal Dr. Pramod Kumar Bajpai.

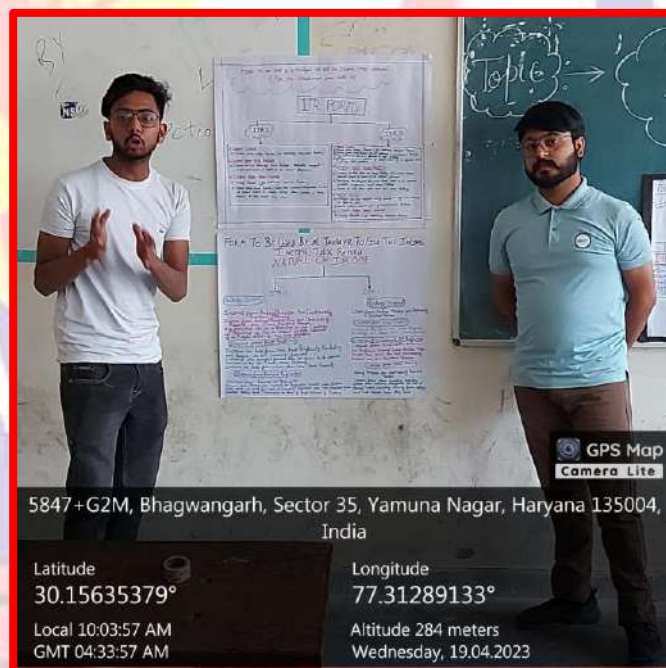
Organised Three Day Session on Mastering Excel from April 3-5, 2023. Mr. Lakhpat Singh (Librarian) was the key speaker.
