#### UG COURSES

#### 1. B.A.

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination with English (10+2 standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with at least 35% marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join 1st Semester of the Course.

#### 2. B.Com.

A person who has passed any one of the following examinations with English as one of the subjects shall be eligible to join the first year of the Bachelor of Commerce Course. Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) Standard of Board of School Education, Haryana or an Examination recognised by the Academic Council as equivalent thereto with at least 40% marks in the Commerce Group or 50% marks in Non-Commerce Group (Humanities and Science).

#### 3. B.Sc. (Non-Medical & Comp. Sc.)

A candidate should be pass in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) standard of Board of School Education, Haryana or its equivalent examination with 40% marks in the aggregate having English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematicsas compulsory subjects.

#### 4. BBA

A candidate should be pass in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) standard of Board of School Education, Haryana or its equivalent examination with 40% marks in the aggregate.

#### 5. BCA

A candidate should be pass in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) standard of Board of School Education, Haryana or its equivalent examination with 50% marks in the aggregate.

Mathematics is not Compulsory.



#### PG COURSES

#### 1 M.Com.

A person who has passed with at least 45% marks in aggregate of the B.Com. (or) BBA or B.A./B.Sc. with Economics and /or Mathematics examinations of Kurukshetra University or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with English as one of the subjects shall be eligible to join this course.

#### 2 M.A. Hindi

A person who has passed B.A. with Hindi with at least 45% marks in the subject of Hindi or 50% marks in aggregate or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto.

#### 3 M.A. Economics

A person who has passed B.A. with Economics /, B.A. (Honours) in Economics / B.Com. With at least 45% marks in the subject of Economics or 50% marks in aggregate or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto

The students with compartment are required to clear their compartment before the commencement of first semester exams failing which their provisional admission will be cancelled ab-initio.

#### ADD ON COURSE

This Certificate/Diploma/ Advanced Diploma will be awarded in addition to the Regular degree of the University. The students joining the first year degree course can opt simultaneously for one of the following Add-on courses:

- Advertising and Sales Management
- E Marketing
- Community Development and Social Welfare
- Certificate course in Positive Discrimination
- Certificate Course in Human Rights Education



After completing the course for one year, a student is awarded one year Certificate. After completing two years' study of Add-on Course, he/she is awarded a Diploma Certificate and after the completion of 3 years' study of an Add-on Course, he/she is given the Advanced Diploma Certificate.

#### Certificate Courses

#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSIONS

- A student will have to be personally present in college for admission.
- No inter-college migration is allowed after admission in the first year.
- At the time of admission, the following documents are required:
- 1. Original Character certificate from Institution last attended.
- 2. Registration number of the University (if already registered)
  - A student will not be refunded or adjusted the amount paid at the time of admission, if his eligibility is not accepted by the University.
  - After passing B.A.I or B.Com. I, change of Faculty or Subject is not allowed.

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• If a student has passed the last qualifying examination from any board other than Board of School Education, Haryana, he/she will have to submit original "University Migration Certificate'/ Transfer Certificate.

#### NOTE:

- Students will be admitted on the basis of merit.
- All legal disputes relating to the Examination/Admission of students will be subject to Jagadhri Court or Courts having Jurisdiction at Jagadhri.

#### ADMISSION ON FALSE DOCUMENTS

If any student takes admission to any class on the basis of false documents, holding back relevant facts or by supplying incorrect information, his admission would be cancelled ab-initio and legal proceeding against him/her will be initiated.

#### ANTI RAGGING REGULATIONS

Ragging is strictly banned in the College Campus and Hostel.

#### Ragging:

According to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, "Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense or share or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student."

#### Punishment for Ragging:

The offenders will be punished as per the instructions of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra / Haryana Government, and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The punishment may include expulsion from the Institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take the shape of withholding scholarships or other benefits; debarring from representation in events; withholding results; suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess, and the like. If the individuals committing or abetting ragging are not / cannot be identified, collective punishment can be awarded to act as deterrent

#### IMPORTANT RULES FOR THE STUDENTS

#### ATTENDANCE RULES

It is mandatory for the students to attend not less than 75% of total lectures delivered in each subject, in theory and practical separately. Weekly attendance report of all the students will be put on the college website. If a student



remains absent from the class for 14 days or more in a month, his / her name will be struck off from the college rolls and he / she will have to seek readmission as per rule. Re-Admission fee will be Rs.500/-

#### LEAVE RULES

- Application for leave from college should be submitted on the prescribed Leave Application Form. It should be signed by Parents/Guardians.
- In case of sickness, Medical Certificate should be submitted during leave days.
- A student who remains absent in the class will be fined @ 5/- per period. Fine will be collected Semester wise.

#### LIBRARY RULES

- A student can be issued books on the basis of Identity card for 28 days only.
- After due date of book, fine would be charged Re. 1/- per day, per Book.
- If any page is torn off or book is mutilated/spoiled in any form or lost, the student shall be required to either deposit a new copy of the book plus technical charges Rs. 50 or MRP of the book plus technical charges Rs. 50. Minimum charges will be Rs100/- in case the price of the book is below Rs. 100/-
- In case the Reference Book is lost, then MRP + 50% of MRP of the Book will be charged from the User.
- If any student is caught stealing the book from the library, disciplinary action will be taken against him in addition to a minimum fine of Rs. 500/-.
- The Book Security (Refundable) would be based on the Book's MRP with a rounding of Rs. 10/-.

#### INTERNAL ASSESSMENT RULES

- Internal assessment for undergraduate classes Semester I, II, III, IV, V  $\not\in$  VI and all post graduate classes will be of 20 Marks in each theory paper based on the following criteria:
- Two hand-written Assignments: 05 Marks Each
- One Class Test: 05 Marks
- Attendance: 05 Marks



#### CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS

- If a student fails to attend 75% of the total lectures delivered in each subject, the University examination roll number shall be detained as per norms.
- Indiscipline in the College campus amounts to striking off the names from the college rolls.
- Wearing of Bonafide Identity Card in the campus and classes is compulsory. The students without Identity Card will not be allowed to enter in the college.
- Damage to the College property would invite a fine double the damage and / or striking off the name from the College rolls.
- Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited. Any student using cell phone in the class/campus would invite a fine of Rs. 500/- and / or forfeiture of Cell Phone.
- Smoking and drinking is prohibited in the College campus and hostels.
- Students are not allowed to bring/invite outsiders to the college premises.

In case of any grievance, the Students are advised to put it before college Grievance Committee/Principal. If any student approaches to any external authority/media directly, his/her name may be struck off from the college rolls.

Students must read the Notice board regularly to get information about instructions/orders issued by the Principal from time to time.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE

Every student will have to deposit the fees as per notification on the notice Board. If the student fails to deposit the fees as per date mentioned, he/she will be charged fine after that as per notice circulated. The names of such students will be struck off from the College rolls, if the students fail to deposit their fee after stipulated time period. A student seeking re-admission will have to deposit the fees as per the College rules. It is the responsibility of the student to deposit the fees on the date notified by the college office. No fee deposited in the college is refundable or adjustable.

#### REFUND OF SECURITY

A student can get back his security amount deposited at the time of admission. It will be refunded between 1st to 31st March of the year after leaving the College. No refund of security will be allowed after 31st March and the security will lapse to the College.
